I try not to miss church each Sunday. I do enjoy being with our tribe often, so I can ground myself with sane, uplifting, supportive folks. I think the


world would be a better place if everyone were Unitarian Universalist. Our principles are just what everyone needs.






Recipe of the Month

Brussels Sprout Hash and Eggs

(Original recipe from KetoDietApp.com)

- 4 cups brussels sprouts
- 4 cups (280g) sliced button mushrooms
- 8 slices of bacon, high fat content
- 4 large eggs
- 3 tbsp high-heat cooking fat like ghee, butter or coconut oil



Meanwhile, clean and thinly slice the mushrooms with a knife. Prepare the sprouts by removing the hard stems and finely slice them (best if sliced thin on a mandolin).

Place the mushrooms in another heavy-bottom pan greased with your preferred cooking fat. Cook them over medium heat for 5-10 minutes until they start to caramelize. Stir 3-4 times to avoid burning.

When the mushrooms are browned, add the sliced Brussels sprouts. Cook for 10-15 minutes stirring frequently to prevent burning.

When the sprouts are fork-tender, add the bacon.

Fry four eggs separately (or if you like sunny side up, make four wells in the skillet and cook the eggs right in the hash). Divide into four servings, each with a fried egg on top.
